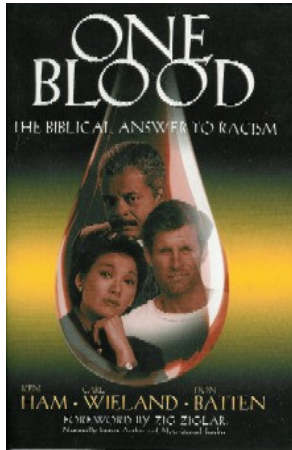


# Read 'Em and Reap!

It's beyond question that all people are descendants of the first "Adam", but look at Acts 17:26: "He has made all nations of men of ONE BLOOD to dwell on all the face of the earth". If we want to shape our world according to biblical

understanding, we must abandon the distinction between the so-called races. There is only one race. In this book, these men deal with issues pertinent to the topic: Natural Selection, Genetics, "interracial" marriage and the "races". They also refute some pseudo-biblical arguments for race differences and take an in-depth look at "stone-age people", Australian pygmies, and others that have been classified as less-than-human.

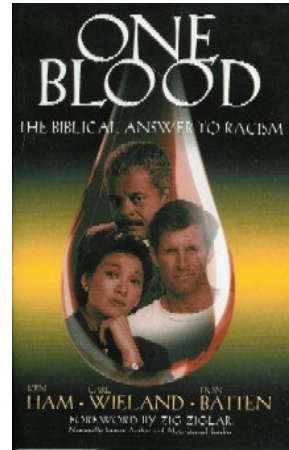
There is much helpful information in this book. Plus, it has lots of charts and diagrams and picture illustrations. It also answers the question about Cain's wife!
